## Proposal 3: identify priority ethnicity topics to provide additional analysis

There is a risk where further analysis, for example multivariable regression analysis, is published that this can lead to misinterpretation, or interpretation which is influenced by ideology. For instance, if an analysis of the relationship between ethnicity and income is adjusted for education the adjusted results can be presented as 'removing the effect of education'. However, in this instance education is on the causal pathway from ethnicity to income rather than being a confounder of the relationship. It is therefore inappropriate to present the adjusted associations from the multivariable model as in some way more 'truthful' than the unadjusted associations. Presenting this sort of information appropriately and accurately requires detailed care and attention, and a thoughtful approach to thinking about causal pathways. It is difficult to do this without being influenced by ideology.
